COACHES NOTES

Included are our year end reports on meals served and Loaves and Fishes report on clients served. The meal count has been about the same for the last several years, good news there are less people finding themselves without shelter living on the streets. More people are shopping at Loaves and Fishes this year. The count is up from 9,412 clients last year to 13,351 in 2023, a 45% increase. We are staying open longer (past 11:00am.) so everyone can shop for what they need.

Also is attached our budget for this year 2024 and last year. Most of the increases are in payroll expenses, we have been increasing the rate of pay over the last several years to get up to the \$15.00 an hour minimum wage requirement. The other large increase was in food purchases for Loaves and Fishes. Most of the food we use comes from our pick-ups from local grocery stores, Feeding Tampa Bay and food drives, but we had to purchase items like jams and canned meats.
