COACHES NOTES

We have had our busiest summer to date, our meal counts in the soup kitchen averaging 170 per day or 5500 per month. Loaves and Fishes had its busiest months, in September serving 1345 clients. The average is around 1000 per month. Britney and her team of volunteers have been opening at 8:30am.- 11:00am. to meet the demand with 100 plus or more shoppers every Monday and Friday.

Our vans are on the road 7 days a week picking up foods from local grocery stores. This year we've been picking up from Meals on Wheels more often than in the past. Recently Stuff-the Bus items have been available to Our Daily Bread. Feeding Tampa Bay deliveries on Wednesday are providing food we use in both programs.

Angie and her team have been cleaning up and organizing our storerooms all summer to make them more efficient. The extra labor has increased our payroll cost over our budgeted cost this year. We also have had added food expense. Repairs on our aging equipment is also over our budget. We have had problems with our heated serving table and our flat grill in the kitchen which still isn't working properly.

On the financial side individual gifts are ahead of last year, but receipts from grants, trusts and estates are down \$50,000 from last year and we have no Manatee County funding anymore. With our increasing costs and lower receipts, it's going to be a very tight year. We are praying that things will improve over the holiday season.

Speaking of the holiday season we are planning our 7-Days of Christmas Giveaways beginning Monday, December 18th, and going thru Monday, December 25th. As in previous years we will have a different item each day to gift our clients starting with blankets, tee shirts, hats and gloves, sweatshirts, socks and underwear, goody bags, tags and bikes. If you are in the holiday spirit, come in and help it's from 9:00am-12:00noon we need you and it is great fun!

After the last storm, Adalia on August 30th we discovered a leak in the roof on the 705 building in the parking lot. We called our friends at Manson Roofing for a repair. Upon inspection, the roof needs to be replaced. We applied for a grant from the Disaster Relief Fund at the Manatee Community Foundation to help pay for the roof replacement.
